



The GRAMCORD Parsings are linked to the Wheeler Syntax Notes. The Wheeler Syntax Notes are an extensive resource that explain the grammatical categories of Greek Grammar (there are Wheeler Syntax Notes for Hebrew as well). In our case, we see that the word μένω in Philippians 1:25 is a verb in the future tense. The links you see to the right of each grammatical category are the links to the Syntax Notes. When we click on the link next to Future, the GRAMCORD Parsings window immediately displays the Wheeler Syntax Notes entry for the future tense. Often there will be further links within the syntax articles, as the notes are quite extensive. If you would like, you can temporarily maximize or stretch (like pictured here) the GRAMCORD Parsings window to see more of the syntax article at one time, as some are long. Then just minimize the Parsings window back into place.
