

For more advanced searches, use the Search Type options to search by verse, clause, or stop (periods, commas, etc.) or designate between Order Specific and Not Order Specific.

Use the Save feature to save searches for future use.

By clicking the Advanced tab, you can designate the text you wish to search. Search the entire New Testament, or limit your search to a specific book or corpus (e.g., Pauline lit., Johannine lit., gospels, etc.). In our search for μένω, we are going to extend the search to the entire New Testament.

In CLASS Type, you will first designate the type of word for your first. In our case we are searching for μένω, which is a verb. In the pull down menu under CLASS Type, we choose Verb.
